We are children...

At the « K a n n e r n a s c h t », our day-care house for children, kids as from early age can attend learning activities in Luxembourgish and French languages, profit from school support to help them with their schoolwork, have lunch in the canteen and take part in many cultural and discovery activities.

All those activities try to involve the children's parents as well as other actors and partners like the teaching staff as well as local associations.

We are youngsters...

At the youth center «Centre de Rencontre pour Jeunes - AMIGO », youngsters can request homework assistance, take part in many different in-door and out-door activities, tailored to teach respect and tolerance, and increase self-confidence for young people

The « médiacteurjeunes / streetwork » team is in touch with young people from the northern suburbs of Luxembourg city. People seeking assistance are welcomed at the « D O - S t a t i o n » in Dommeldange next to the train stop.

We connect the people living in the northern suburbs of Luxembourg city...

The « Travail Social Communautaire » team encourages residents to participate in the activities from local associations, through activities for young and old.

We support interculturalism in schools by organizing happenings ...

The « Centre de Documentation et d'Animation InterCulturelles - I K L » develops educational materials and intercultural projects to ground school and secondary school. The material is aimed at intercultural education, discovery of migratory history and the respect of everyone's different cultural identities, as well as managing conflicts between young people of different nationalities.



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We support refugees all along their integration path ...

Within the project «M a ' a n ! Z e s u m m e n ! », ASTI organizes Literacy courses for people who cannot read or write, classes to study our Latin alphabet for people who can read and write another alphabet, as well as intensive French language courses by volunteers, to practice French from A1 level to B1.

Refugees who attend B1 level classes in French language can then take part in the «C o n n e c t i o n » project which prepares them for employability and includes 14 information sessions on Luxembourg, 6 work preparation workshops and a non-paid internship of 240 hours during up to 6 months.

ASTI is about migrants and undocumented people ...

At the « G u i c h e t I N F O - M I G R A N T S » our specialists of Immigration and International Protection Law answer questions about residence and work permits as well as regarding the asylum procedure. In this way, we offer a free support for the people who have obtained political status and intend to request a family reunification.

Thanks to volunteers, we offer a public writer service to help people write letters, fill out forms and better manage the administrative procedures.

We are talkative ...

The «A g e n c e I n t e r c u l t u r e l l e » proposes an interpretation service for the events: This allows to conduct a meeting in a language and to offer, with a system of translation kit and an interpreter, an oral translator in real time in one or several other languages. The agency is involved in local community projects and supports integration with the exchange of good practices.

The *Agence Interculturelle* offers people who committed to a *contrat d'accueil d'integration* to participate in conversation tables and language cafés, volunteer language coaches to practice the language in a pleasant way, as well as training for volunteers interested in the teaching a language

We work on political questions ...

The «c o - o r d i n a t i o n o f p o l i t i c a l w o r k » includes contact with asylum seekers, updating information on asylum and migration on the asti.lu website, editing ASTINFO magazine, lobbying for equal rights, for supporting undocumented migrants and rejected international protection seekers. We also coordinate information on exchange platforms between associations which are active in the line of defense of political rights and asylum seekers.



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We are volunteers

Numerous projects operate thanks to the resources and skills of our volunteers - refugees and resident volunteers – like the writing of information brochures, digital information platforms, teaching manuals, dictionaries and small cultural guides about Luxembourg
